1.1: Introduction

This is the Stage B Summary Report prepared by Knight Kavanagh & Page (KKP) for the Central Lancashire authorities of Chorley Council, Preston City Council, South Ribble Borough Council and its partners. This report presents the winter sports supply and demand information for the Central Lancashire Playing Pitch & Outdoor Sport Strategy (PPOSS), in accordance with Sport England's Playing Pitch Strategy Guidance: An Approach to Developing and Delivering a Playing Pitch Strategy.

It presents the non-technical audit results on a sport-by-sport basis based on findings from assessments and research carried out in February 2025. It also highlights initial key issues as identified by clubs and based on the consultation carried out by KKP to date.

1.2: Rugby union

Consultation

There are two rugby union clubs playing in Central Lancashire with both located in Preston. Only Preston Grasshoppers RFC has responded to consultation requests to date which results in a 50% response rate. Continued efforts will be made to obtain a response from Lancashire Typhoons RFC.

Since the previous study both Chorley RFC and Leyland Warriors RFC have folded with the latter now solely a rugby league club.

Disused provision

As per the previous PPS, one rugby union pitch was marked out at Archbishop Temple High School (PR2 8RA) and one pitch located at Moss Side Recreation Ground (PR26 7XU) which are now no longer marked out for rugby union.

Supply

The audit of rugby union pitches across Central Lancashire identifies a total of 17 pitches across 11 unique sites, of which, 15 pitches across nine sites are available for community use. The non-technical assessment of rugby union pitches identifies that there are two (12%) good quality pitches, seven (41%) standard quality pitches and eight (47%) poor quality pitches as shown in further detail below.

Ancillary facilities

Ancillary facility ratings are primarily influenced by the type of amenities which are available on a site accompanied by their quality, such as a clubhouse, changing rooms, car parking, dedicated official and spectator facilities. Good quality ancillary facilities are particularly important for rugby clubs as they can assist with income generation. Furthermore, it is becoming increasingly important for the provision to be inclusive, particularly due to growing women's and girls', disability and junior/mini demand.

Although the size and configuration of ancillary provision may alter based on the sports using the provision, and the number of pitches it services, generally the same principles are recommended to allow for varied use from all demographics:

- ◀ Accessible changing areas which can be separated, or are private/self-contained, to allow for separate male/female/all gender or senior/junior separation.
- ◀ A private accessible changing room (with relevant changing and showering provision) for someone who requires assistance.
- ◀ Separate female / male / all gender toilet provision.
- ◀ Suitably designed and specified showering cubicles to all users to maintain dignity and privacy whilst showering.

Open plan changing rooms and showering facilities can provide a significant barrier to many people resulting in them either not taking part or having a poorer sporting experience.

As a result of the above, those ancillary facilities that do not meet the above criteria, cannot be rated anything higher than standard quality.

The Club states the changing rooms are standard quality following some improvements made (painting etc.). However, the facilities will need full refurbishment eventually given the age and general wear and tear.

Key findings from consultation (to date)

Preston Grasshoppers RFC

- ◀ The Club has one team in each age group from u5 to u18, five senior men's and one senior women's team. It should be noted that although the Club has five senior men's teams, its struggling to get three men's teams out on match days due to players not being available and having other commitments.
- ◀ The Club aspires to improve the drainage on its two standard quality pitches and is in the process of looking for funding.

- ◀ In addition to the pitches above, the Club has some land adjacent to the site which has no marked pitches or rugby posts but is used for age grade rugby.
- ◀ The Club highlights an aspiration to install solar panels to become more energy sufficient and to reduce its running costs.
- ◀ It should be noted that many club/sports currently use this site including, cricket, archery, cycling, shooting and squash.

1.3: Hockey

Consultation and demand

There are four hockey clubs playing across Central Lancashire with two located in Chorley, one in Preston and one in South Ribble. All four clubs have responded to consultation requests which results in an 100% response rate.

Longridge HC is known to import demand to use hockey suitable facilities within Preston as an overspill venue with its primary facility located in Ribble Valley (Longridge Sports Centre). Attempts are still ongoing to consult with the Club and understand its current position.

Since the previous study, Garstang HC has returned all its demand to Wyre with no teams currently using facilities within Central Lancashire as an overspill venue. Additionally, Fulwood HC has folded.

Supply

In Central Lancashire, there is a total of six full size AGPs with three pitches located in Preston, one pitch located in South Ribble and one pitch located in Chorley. Five of the six full size AGPs are available for community use with the pitch located at Broughton Business Enterprise College & High School unavailable for community use due to not being provided with sports lighting.

The number of full size AGPs has changed slightly since the previous PPS, with a reduction of three pitches due to being converted to 3G, one pitch is located at Preston Sports Arena (UCLAN), one pitch at Parklands High School and one pitch at St Marys Catholic High School Leyland.

Additionally, there are 12 smaller size AGPs with nine located in Preston, two in South Ribble and one in Chorley.

Quality

Of the full size AGPs two are assessed as good quality, one pitch is assessed as standard quality and three pitches are assessed as poor quality located at Broughton Business Enterprise College & High School, Preston Sports Arena (UCLAN) and Buckshaw Village Community Association.

Holy Cross High School funded and resurfaced its hockey suitable AGP in December 2021 and therefore is now good quality. There is currently no community hockey usage on the pitch but the School stated it would be open to this if clubs were to approach them in the future.

A summary of supply is set out overleaf.

Key findings from consultation

Leyland & Chorley HC

- ◀ The Club has three senior men's, three senior women's and a junior section. It reports the Club has grown recently and has plans to continue this trend but the poor quality pitch at Buckshaw Village Community Associations is affecting this.
- ◀ It highlights the pitch has never been maintained to a standard it should have been and is in need of immediate resurface.
- ◀ Ancillary facilities are standard quality with home and away changing rooms, lockers, showers, toilets, kitchen and storage provided. The Club aspires to have its own clubhouse to accommodate players/spectators after matches.

Preston HC

- ◀ The Club has seven senior men's teams, three senior ladies' teams and three junior teams.
- ◀ It mainly plays at Preston Sports Club but does occasionally use Preston Sports Arena (UCLAN) as an overspill venue.
- ◀ The Club states the clubhouse and changing facilities are good quality due to recent refurbishment with bar, kitchen, four changing rooms, showers, toilets, umpires changing room and storage.
- ◀ It does report a current issue with car parking due to not having enough spaces especially on weekends.
- ◀ Sports lights at Preston Sport Club have recently been upgraded in 2022.

Brookfield HC

- ◀ The Club has three senior ladies' teams.
- ◀ It states its men's team and ladies development team have folded with the latter merging with the 2nd team.
- ◀ Additionally, its number of junior members has declined due to the lack of training venues.
- ◀ It currently uses Walton-le-dale High School to accommodate all its demand.
- ◀ The Club reports running Back-to-Hockey sessions in the summer months.

Chorley Phoenix HC

- ◀ The Club states the number of senior teams has increase following recruitment and the Clubs strategy. Additionally, it started junior hockey 18 months ago which is increasing in members.
- ◀ It currently uses Walton-le-dale High School and Buckshaw Village Community Association to accommodate its demand. The Club state it can't access Walton-Le-Dale High School during the week due to being at capacity.
- ◀ The Club highlights running Back-to-Hockey and a summer hockey league.
- ◀ It aspires to play and train at the same venue but due to capacity issues at Walton-Le-Dale High School this currently isn't possible.
- ◀ The Club states the pitch at Buckshaw Village Community Association is poor quality and in need of a full resurface.

1.4: Football

Consultation and demand

In total there are 820 teams across 112 clubs which originate from Central Lancashire. The level of imported and exported demand will be further explored at Stage C.

The overall current consultation response rate from football clubs equates to a team response rate of 42% (346/820 teams and 36/112 clubs). The response rate breakdown by Local Authority can be seen in the table below. Continued efforts are being made to increase this with assistance from Lancashire FA.

Supply

In total, there are 280 pitches across 119 unique sites in Central Lancashire, of which, 260 across 109 sites are available for community use. All pitches that are not available for community use are either located at education sites or elite sports clubs' facilities such as Preston North End Football Club.

The total number of pitches since the previous study (2018) has decreased (by 5%) which saw 294 grass football pitches across 132 sites, of which, 281 pitches across 112 sites were identified as being available for community use on some level. The changes in the number of pitches are mainly due to pitch reconfiguration at sites. However, it should be noted that more pitches are available for community use in 2025.

Quality

The quality of football pitches across Central Lancashire has been assessed via a combination of site visits (undertaken in February 2025) using non-technical assessments as determined by the FA, user consultation and PitchPower to reach and apply an agreed rating as follows:

- ◀ Poor

The percentage parameters used for the non-technical assessments were as follows: Good (>80%), Standard (50-80%), Poor (<50%). The final quality ratings assigned to the sites also take into account the user quality ratings gathered from consultation.

Pitch quality primarily influences the carrying capacity of a site; often pitches lack the drainage and maintenance necessary to sustain levels of use. Pitches that receive little to no ongoing repair or post-season remedial work are likely to be assessed as poor, therefore limiting the number of games they are able to accommodate each week without it having a detrimental effect on quality.

Conversely, well maintained pitches that are tended to regularly are likely to be of a higher standard and capable of taking a number of matches without a significant reduction in surface quality.

In Central Lancashire, 41 pitches are assessed as good quality, 96 as standard quality and 123 as poor quality. Site visits indicate many sites suffer from poor drainage, damage to the playing surface, litter and dog fouling. Overall pitch quality has improved since the previous study in 2018 with a significant increase in the number of good quality community available pitches and fewer poor quality pitches.

1.5: Third generation turf (3G) pitches

Supply

There are 19 3G pitches which are 11v11 size within Central Lancashire all of which are available for community use and have sports lighting. Most of these are provided in South Ribble (eight or 42%), with seven (37%) provided in Preston and four (21%) are provided in Chorley.

Since 2018 there has been an increase of seven 3G pitches with one pitch each provided at Preston Sports Arena (UCLAN), St Marys Catholic High School Leyland, West Way Sports Hub (Astley Village Playing Field), Jim Fowlers Memorial Ground (Euxton Villa FC), Parklands High School and two new pitches provided at Withy Grove Park (Bamber Bridge Leisure Centre).

Once the demand for football is fully established, further analysis will be carried out to determine the likely shortfalls in provision.

Quality

Of the 11v11 3G pitches in Preston, three are assessed as good quality and four as standard quality located at Ashton Community Science College, Corpus Christi Catholic High School, Fulwood Academy and Preston College.

In South Ribble, two are assessed as good quality, four as standard quality and one as poor quality located at Runshaw College primarily due to the age of the surface.

In Chorley, three are assessed as good quality due to being installed recently and one as standard quality located at Bishop Rawstone C of E Language College.

Of the smaller size provision two are assessed as good quality, seven are standard quality and five are poor quality. Further site-by-site information can be found in the table below.

Key findings from consultation

- ◀ Euxton Girls states the pitches at Greenside Recreation Ground are poor quality due to heavy usage and poor drainage. However, it is currently accessing the Grass Pitch Maintenance Fund to make improvements.
- ◀ St Michael's High School highlights it would benefit from a 3G pitch due to losing half of its playing field for a long period of time over winter due to poor drainage.
- ◀ Euxton Villa FC states plans to finish the car park and fencing around the 3G pitch as currently only half is enclosed by high fences.
- ◀ Astley & Buckshaw Juniors currently has no access to changing facilities/kitchen facilities at West Way Sports Hub which is affecting the Clubs growth.
- ◀ Astley & Buckshaw Juniors is currently in conversation with Euxton CC with regards to sharing its facilities (grass provision and ancillary facilities).
- ◀ Both Preston College and Ashton Community Science College highlights its 11v11 3G pitch is at the end of its life span and needs resurfacing.
- ◀ Fulwood Amateur AFC states it's at risk of losing its newly developed (*circa* five years ago) junior section due to the lack of facilities for both matches and training in the local area.
- ◀ Penwortham Priory Academy states its 11v11 3G pitch is at the end of its life span and needs resurfacing. It should be noted that a sinking fund is in place for this. The Academy is currently in the process of drafting a bid for the Football Foundation. Additionally, it aspires to have a second 11v11 3G pitch at the site.
- ◀ Penwortham St Teresa's FC aspires to have its own site with changing facilities. Its currently using several sites which is impacting the grow especially on the girl's side.
- ◀ Lancashire FA has plans to resurface both its 11v11 3G pitch and smaller size 3G pitch.
- ◀ Cadley FC is in the process of renewing its lease across its three sites South Grove, Conway Drive and Sherwood Park. Additionally, it aspires to develop changing facilities at Sherwood Park which currently has no facilities.
- ◀ JFC Chorley is currently traveling to Wigan to access facilities for both matches and training due to the lack of facilities in Chorley.
- ◀ Multiple clubs which responded to consultation raised issues relating to leagues that now play on a Sunday which makes accommodating teams more difficult.

1.6: Next steps

The Central Lancashire PPOSS Assessment Report is due to be submitted to the Steering Group end of May 2025, this will include all sports including the winter sports.

The report will focus on reporting the findings of the extensive research, consultation, site assessment, data analysis and GIS mapping work to deliver:

- ◀ An analysis of qualitative site visits.
- ◀ A summary of consultation with a variety of stakeholders, including officers, governing bodies, league secretaries, clubs and schools.
- ◀ Supply and demand analysis using the methodology in accordance with Sport England's Guidance 'Playing Pitch Strategy and Guidance' and 'Assessing needs and opportunities guide for indoor and outdoor sports facilities.

Each sport-by-sport section will provide a quantitative summary of provision and a map showing the distribution of facilities. It will also provide information about the availability of facilities for the local community, and the details of governing body regional strategic plans (where they exist).

It is important to note that the Assessment Report will not, at this stage, incorporate site-specific recommendations (in relation to meeting deficiencies and dealing with surpluses). Once the facts outlined (including site information, number of teams etc.) have been agreed by the steering group, a strategy and action plan will be developed.
